Level One Triathlon Canada Officials Course April 29 10:00am-12:00pm

- Learn the basics of the Competition Rules (appropriate to provincial competition)
- Understand the rationale behind the rules
- Learn how to enforce rules
- Level one officials work under the guidance of more experienced officials (Level 2+)
- Work at Kids of Steel and adult races in the province

Level Two Triathlon Canada Officials Course April 29 1:00-4:00pm

Designed for those who have participated as officials in the past and want to re-certify or expand their knowledge of the rules of triathlon. Or for those interested in organizing a multi-sport event.

- Gain a further understanding of rule interpretation and implementation
- Learn more about organizing an event and operations
- Understand your role as an official and your relationship with event organizers
- Enable you to act as a Race Referee (when you feel ready) at provincial competitions
- The gateway to officiating at the national and international level

Participants taking the courses are asked to commit to officiating a minimum of 3 events per year in order to gain practical experience. All Triathlon Manitoba officials receive free annual memberships.

The courses will be facilitated by Kelly Mahoney, who has 15 years' experience officiating at the local and international level.
